## CLEANING AND HYGIENE POLICY

PSC is fully committed to safeguarding the health and safety of all participants, volunteers and staff. For this reason, effective immediately, all PSC staff and volunteers, regardless of position or authority, must comply with the following facility cleaning and hygiene policy:

PSC is responsible for explaining to all staff and volunteers the cleaning protocols and frequency of all common areas and equipment.

PSC is responsible for explaining to all staff and volunteers the proper use of cleaning supplies and safety concerns of products used.

PSC is responsible for explaining to all staff and volunteers how to clean and disinfect after persons suspected/confirmed to have COVID-19 have been in the facility.

PSC is responsible for providing a cleaning supplies to all staff and volunteers. We will have available a cleaning schedule/log, procedures, and chemical MSD sheet for all cleaning supplies.

PSC Staff must ensure:

- All staff and volunteers understand facility cleaning and hygiene procedures;
- Staff, volunteers and participants do not share equipment, when possible. High-touch surfaces and equipment are disinfected between users;
- Equipment is disinfected after use
- Only EPA approved disinfectants effective against COVID-19 are used;
- Staff, volunteers and participants are provided hand sanitizer for use during events.

Staff and volunteers are responsible for:

- Letting PSC know when cleaning supplies are low;
- Performing cleaning as scheduled;
- Using proper disinfecting supplies.
