EXAMPLES of VALID pre-season requests, if they are made during the reschedule window:

EXAMPLES of NON-VALID requests that other teams ask our PSC managers:

- Their coach is also coaching another team and the games conflict. Respond promptly "NO".
- Team wants to do a tournament. Respond promptly "NO".
